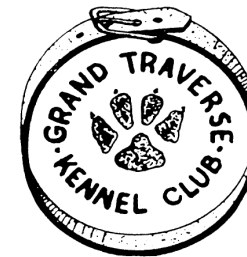

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete, but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

MIXED BREED ENTRIES

These trials are open to Mixed Breed exhibitors under the AKC Canine Partners program. When completing the entry form, please list "All American Dog" for the breed. Additionally, provide your AKC Canine Partners listing number and check-mark "AKC No." on the form.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place Indoors on a Soccer Carpet and pad surface. Ring size will be minimum of 80' X 100".

No entries will be accepted by phone or fax delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Barbara Peters at dogpatch@charter.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

Dark green qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

A MACH rosette and decorated MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PAX bar and PAX rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a PAX title.

MOVE-UP CONDITIONS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an AKC agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing, not later than Monday, September 27, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. E-mail moves-ups must include the phrase "Accept this as my signature." Dogs that are moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. Move-ups for the Saturday & Sunday trials will be accepted by the Agility Trial Secretary until one half hour after close of the last class on Friday & Saturday at the trial site. Move-up forms are included in this premium and are available at the site from the Trial Secretary.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

. **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

. **Dogs under the age of 6 months are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.**

. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Grand Traverse Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Grand Traverse Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Grand Traverse Kennel Club or any official thereof.

. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

. **No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds minus \$15/day administrative fees will be given to bitches in season, along with all dogs that can't complete due to injury, upon receipt of an excuse from a licensed Veterinarian written on his/her letterhead. All refund requests must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. Overpayments of less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Entry Confirmation

Confirmation of Entry will be via email where an email address is provided. Exhibitors are responsible for insuring information in the conformation e-mail is correct for the dog(s) entered. No corrections will be made after the start of judging on Friday, October 1, 2010. Confirmation letters and judging schedule will be e-mailed/mailed as soon as possible after closing of the trial.

In order to preserve our ability to use our trial site as well as our motel facilities, please pick up after your dogs. On site will be various buckets along with plastic bags.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Grand Traverse Kennel Club and the T-Bay's Soccer Facility will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food will be available on the site. Workers will be given food tickets. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance. No food or beverages, other than water, are allowed on the soccer field.

Limited overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.

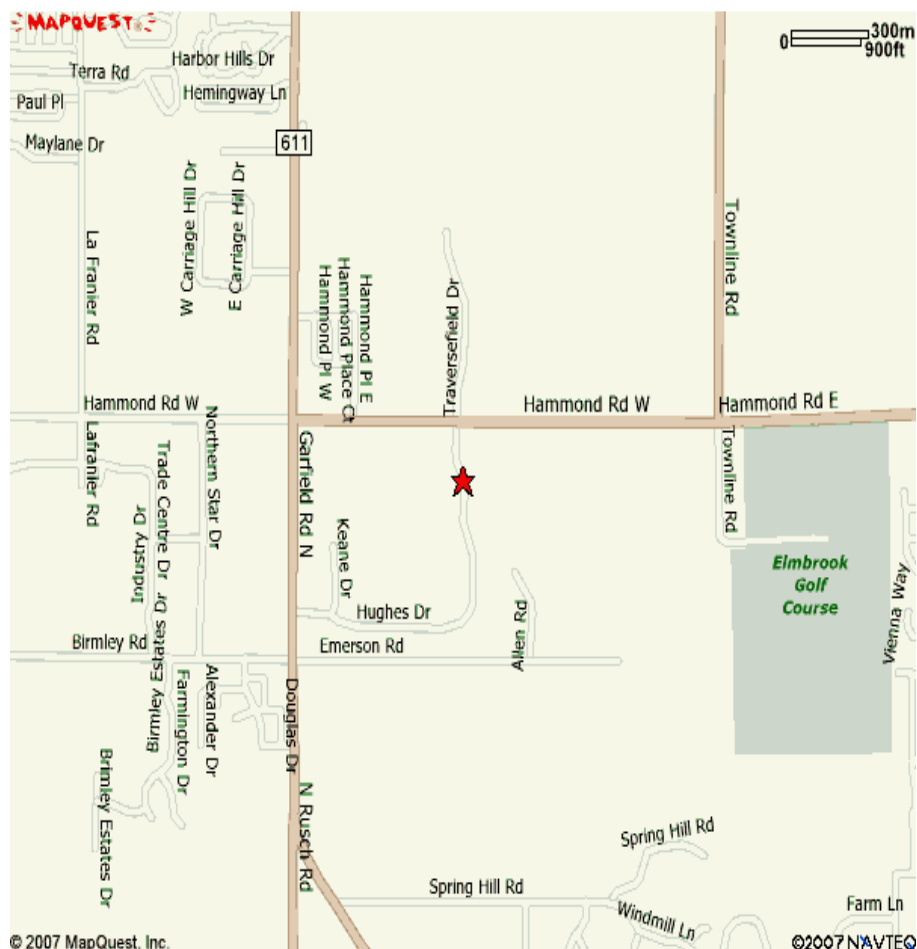
Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

The trial site will be available for set-up on Thursday, September 30, 2010 from 4:00 – 7:00 pm.

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
